## SUSTAINABLE TIPS FOR THE HOLIDAY SEASON

- Compost your food scraps to nurture your garden
- Bring Your Own (BYO) reusables everywhere you go!

## **BEVERAGE CONTAINER RECYCLING – DON'T TRASH THE CASH**



It is never too late to start recycling your bottles and cans. <u>Most beverages</u> packaged in aluminum, glass, plastic and bi-metal containers are eligible for California Redemption Value (CRV) -- 5 cents for containers less than 24 ounces and 10 cents for containers 24 ounces or larger.

Consumers can return their bottles and cans to participating recycling centers to receive CRV redemptions. Find your closest recycling center by visiting <u>CleanLA.com</u>. Remember, Don't Trash the Cash!
