
4th Quarter 2022 Roadmap to a Sustainable Waste Management Future

Sustainable Holiday Season

This holiday season, practice the Four R's (Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, and Rethink) whether you are deciding on the perfect gifts, planning a dinner, or shopping. Here are ideas that promote sustainability and will save you money:

- Keep it simple! The fancier the gift wrapping, gift bags, or greeting card, the less recyclable.
- Wrap gifts in brown craft paper while replacing a bow with a pine cone or a sprig from your tree. Your gifts will look rustic, hand-crafted, and will be eco-friendly.
- Give a gift certificate for spa services, restaurants, or movies rather than buying things.
- When shopping online, try to shop from the same place all at once to avoid multiple deliveries and boxes.
- Homemade gifts such as ornaments, soap/candles, or photobooks are perfect ways to reuse items.

Effective January 1, 2022, Senate Bill 1383 requires that everyone properly recycles food waste and food-soiled paper. Begin reducing food waste by purchasing less.
