1st Quarter 2023 Roadmap to a Sustainable Waste Management Future

Reduce Single-Use Plastics

Lead the way in waste reduction at County facilities. Avoid using plastic utensils and paper napkins, instead use reusable utensils and cloth napkins. When single-use products are unavoidable at County facilities and County-sponsored events, use products that are certified compostable according to County Policy.

Per– and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) are long lasting toxic chemicals that break down very slowly over time. PFAS is widely used in a variety of food service products such as coated paper products, popcorn bags, fast food wrappers and takeout containers.

To comply with County policy, food facilities that provide single-use food ware accessories such as utensils, straws and condiments, should ensure that these



products are PFAS-free, and only be provided to customers upon request. Full-service restaurants in County facilities and venues must use reusable food ware for dine-in customers.
