

# Regional Organic Waste Capacity Survey

- Administrators: County and Consultant
- Duration: January 2022 June 2022
- Purpose:
  - Identifying available capacity within the region
  - Assisting jurisdictions with Implementation Schedules
- Counties: Imperial, Kern, Kings, Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, San Diego, San Luis Obispo, Santa Barbara, and Ventura





# Regional Organic Waste Capacity Survey

 SB 1383 Regulations – Article 11 Section 18992.1(d)(1) states jurisdictions that lack sufficient organic waste recycling capacity are required to:

"Submit an implementation schedule to [CalRecycle] that demonstrates how it will ensure there is enough available capacity to recover the organic waste currently disposed by generators within their jurisdiction by the end of the report period."


• Implementation Schedules must identify facilities, operations, and activities that could be used for additional capacity.



# Regional Organic Waste Capacity Survey







- Deliverables that will be shared with jurisdictions and/or made available on the County's SB 1383 website:
  - Summary report of survey results
  - Map of facilities (Information on map will include, but not limited to, facility names, locations, and capacities)
  - Presentation of findings at final quarterly meeting (tentatively scheduled for June 30<sup>th</sup>)
