

Assessment of Capacity at Regional Organic Waste Processing Facilities – Upcoming Project


- Administrators: County and Consultant



If you answered "No" to Question 1, is your jurisdiction on track to meet the January 1, 2022 deadline for adopting a local ordinance?






Edible Food Disposal Related Question(s)

Will your jurisdiction be prepared to estimate the amount of edible food that will be disposed by commercial edible food generators within your jurisdiction by March 31, 2022?



Edible Food Recovery Capacity Related Question(s)



Will your jurisdiction be prepared to estimate the amount of organic waste that will be disposed by residents and businesses within your jurisdiction by March 31, 2022?








Organic Waste Recycling Capacity Related Question(s)


